Surge in Tennis

The Greater San Diego City Tennis Council wishes everyone a happy (and safe) holiday season! Though it has been a challenging time for many of us, the tennis community has remained strong during these unprecedented times. With a scaled rating of 2 out of 10 in terms of COVID-19 risk level, tennis is one of the safest activities to partake in according to the Texas Medical Association.

Year-over-year growth data showcases a significant increase in racquet sales and tennis participation throughout the nation. According to the Tennis Industry Association's (TIA) Quarterly USA Wholesale Equipment Census, racquet sales in the entry-level category have seen significant growth in the third quarter of 2020 compared to 2019. Youth racquets saw an increase of 40.9% and adult racquets 43.3%. This is even leading to shortages in popular racquets and shoes! Good luck finding an EZONE 98 Tour in the near future!

Additionally, the Physical Activity Council reports 10.08% of the U.S. population are playing tennis, an increase of 50% since 2019. That is an increase of roughly 11 million tennis players in the United States alone. This has translated to participation at local tennis clubs hitting all-time highs.
